**Today is College Monday . . .** and did you know that your Expected Family Contribution (or EFC) from the FAFSA Student Aid Report is likely to remain the same whether you go to a low-cost school or a high-cost school? Don't automatically eliminate colleges with higher costs. For example, if your EFC is \$5,000, at a college with a total cost of \$8,000, you'd be eligible for up to \$3,000 in financial aid, while at a college with a total cost of \$25,000, you'd be eligible for up to \$20,000 in aid. In other words, your family would be asked to contribute the same amount (EFC) at both a low-cost and a high-cost school. Questions? See Ms. Metcalf in 1204.
