The first day of school is Tuesday, August 28th.

School start time will be staggered, with Freshmen coming at 8:15 am and students in grades 10-12 reporting at 12:15 pm.

There will be two bus runs on the first day of school, one at the regular time for Freshmen and one approximately four (4) hours later for grades 10-12. No lunch will be served to grades 10-12.

**Freshman orientation** takes place from 8:15 a.m. - noon on the first day of school and is run by our Link Crew leaders, who are upper class mentors assigned to freshmen advisories (Cardinal

Connections) to build positive relationships with their students throughout the school year. Freshmen will be greeted and directed to the gym, where they will meet their Link Crew leaders, learn about our Cardinal Culture, receive their class schedules, and participate in a number of other activities.

**Grades 10-12** will begin their day at 12:15 in their advisories, where they will receive their schedules and participate in other opening activities.
